## 9. AOCB

- 9.1 Concerns about lack of signage and placing of signage to inform drivers to slow down entering the town from East and West. Also, speeding traffic is a concern in the 40 and 30 MPH areas. Speed Cameras possible? Chair to speak to Inspector McCallum. Would a roundabout be a possibility at Skirling turnoff to promote slower traffic? Thus works at West Linton at Robinland roundabout and there is also a higher Police presence in West Linton
- 9.2 Talks are taking place regarding a possible Community Bus from Edinburgh to take place of services allegedly discontinuing
- 9.3 Planting is going ahead in some beds but in talks with SLC who are doing survey and what lies under these areas. Lack of hanging baskets in Biggar, Chair has complained to SLC, no reply. It was noted the water bowsers to water the baskets are not high in SLC's priorities.
